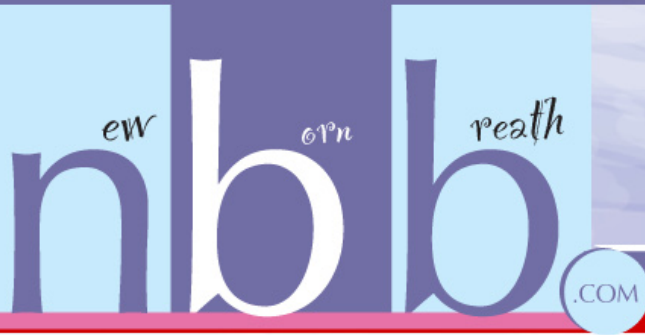

Workshop Information and Requirements

- Included materials, handouts, and AAP/AHA NRP card (Not the NRP Textbook).
- Course approved by Board of Registered Nurses (BRN) (\$5.00) & Midwifery Education Accreditation Counsel (MEAC) (\$10.00) for 8 Contact Hours.
- A deposit of \$85 is due at time of registration; the balance will be collected on the morning of the course.
- A FULL refund will be returned if you cancel due to a birth, illness or death. You must call the morning of, and preferably before the start of class! Otherwise, a \$50.00 fee will be charged!
- Please bring a potluck dish to share at lunch.
- You MUST be on-time to class or the class will end later in the day.
- Ahead of time you MUST read the Textbook of Neonatal Resuscitation, 5th Edition 2006, which comes with a CD-ROM. The book is available from the AAP/AHA/NRP website store at 888-227-1770. ORDER THE BOOK HERE! [5] Shipping can take up to three weeks to deliver unless expedited. Chapters 1-4 and 9 MUST be read before the class. If you need to be tested for medications and intubations, you must also read Chapters 5 & 6 and let me know ahead of time so I can bring the appropriate dolls and tests. Then it is YOUR responsibility to ask me for the test and to skill test you on the day of the class!
- You do not have to buy the book but you MUST read the book ahead of time (this means before you come to class). You can borrow it from someone else too. You can also review the DVD-ROM that comes with the book.
- If you have an older edition of the NRP book it is recommended you read the newer version or review the "Summary of Major Changes to the Guidelines" document on my website: www.newbornbreath.com

Important "Short Course" Requirements

1. You must take and pass the test online (known as the 'Online Evaluation') before you come to class. In order to do that, go to the 1. NRP website at <http://www.aap.org/nrp/nrpmain.html> and click the NRP Online Evaluation button on the right side of the page.
2. You will create an account on the NRP website and then you will purchase a subscription in the amount of \$29 in order to take the 2. test. (This fee is deducted from the amount you pay for the class fee)
***Note that you will have 14 days to complete the online (the written test-online) evaluation once you have purchased your subscription. And then, you must attend Karen's Strange's NRP Short Course within 30 days of passing the Online Evaluation**
3. When you take the online evaluation, you will be required to complete sections 1-4, and 9.*You must print out the completion 3. certificate and bring it to class.
4. Once you pass the Online Evaluation (the written test-online) you will get a verification form that admits you to Karen's class. If, 4. for whatever reason, you do not take the test ahead of time, you MAY NOT come to this shortened class. You may come to the regular full-day class, and you will be expected to be present for entire length of the regular class; there will be no way to shorten the amount of time you will spend in class if you are renewing, that day.
***Note that Short Days are only for renewal classes (those that have taken Karen's class previously, within the last 3 years and have taken the online evaluation ahead of time).**

If you do not want to do the class this way, taking the test online before you come to class, then you are more than welcome to come to the normal full day class and do the test in class the way it has always been done in Karen's class.
